An extension activity on “Survey on Hygiene Condition and Cleanliness Drive” organized by School of Basic and Applied Sciences in collaboration with NSS Club on 14th October 2022 in Garhi Wazidpur, Sohna under **Clean India 2.0 campaign** of Government of India. During the program, a survey was done from door to door by the students regarding Hygiene Condition and Cleanliness Drive. The main objective of the program was to aware the villagers regarding the issues of hygiene and public sanitation conditions. The cleanliness drive initiated by Dr Chandra Mohan (NSS Coordinator) and Dr Neeraj Kumari (School event coordinator) with the interactive session with the students where they told the students about the need and importance of sanitation and cleanliness in life. Students were divided into six groups. They did the survey of almost 60 houses where they asked the questions regarding the waste generated in the house, its outlet, awareness regarding waste materials, availability of dustbin in the house, quality of food and water they use and many more questions. During the survey, it was found that most of the villagers are not aware about the biodegradable and non-biodegradable waste. They have the facility of dustbin but there is no facility of garbage truck due to which they are throwing the garbage

outside the village in open. Students informed the villagers about the diseases caused due to the waste found in open area. Students also told about the harmful effects of plastics.

With the motto of “Swachh Bharat” and clean India 2.0, all volunteers picked plastic and waste papers from the various sites of village and dump them in the garbage bags as the drive was one of the many steps taken by the educational institute towards India’s Swachh Bharat Abhiyan initiated by our Hon’ble Prime Minister, Sh Narendra Modi.

In the last, Dr Chandra Mohan gave vote of thanks to the Pradhan of Village and facilitate the villagers with a memento.
