#### **Conclusion**

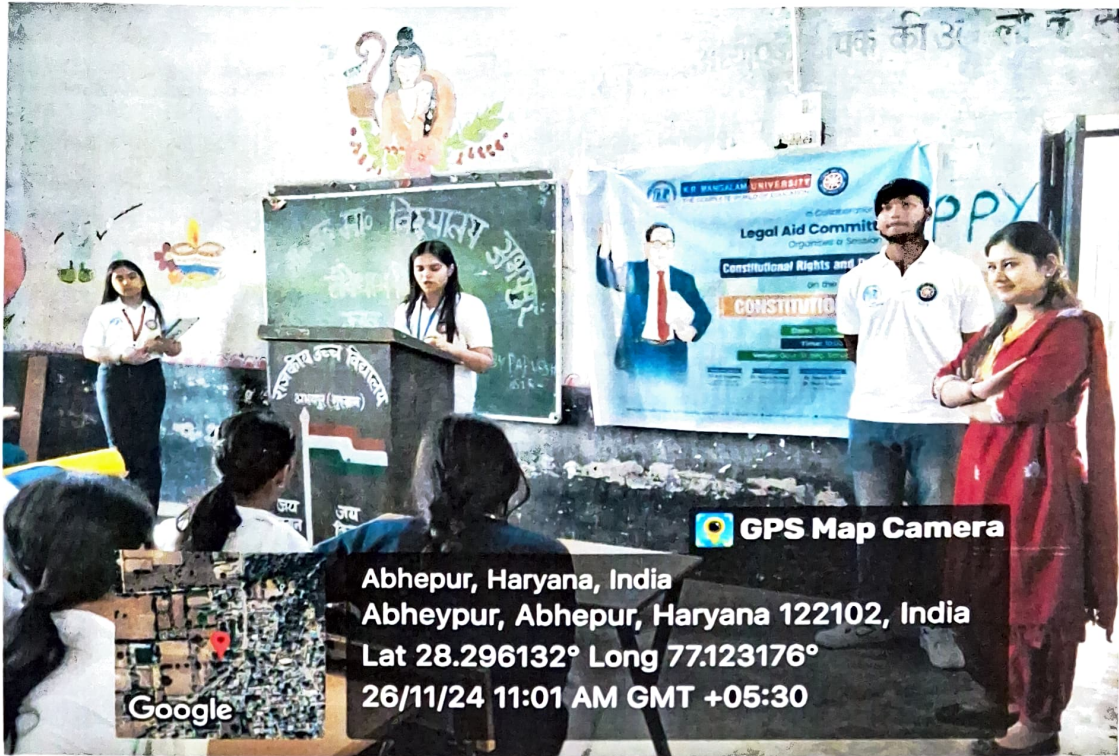

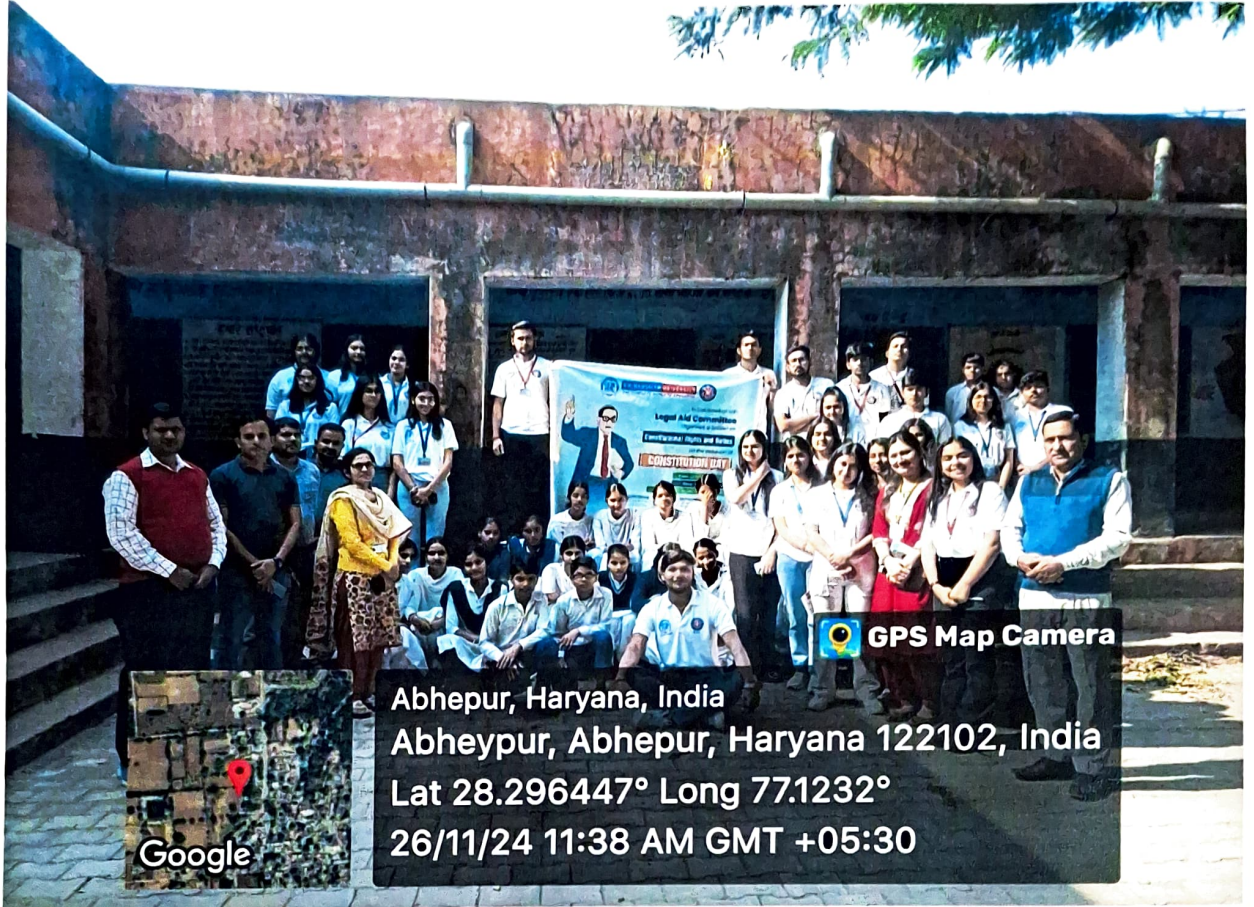
